MISSION: The mission of Arapahoe House is to provide a continuum of accessible, affordable, and effective services for individuals and families with alcohol, drug and other behavioral health problems.







TITLE OF POSITION: Children's Learning Center Volunteer

OBJECTIVE: Assist Arapahoe House staff in providing quality childcare for children ages 0-12 years while their parents participate in treatment activities.

DUTIES MAY INCLUDE:

-  Participate in fun and educational activities with children ages 0-12 years.
-  Assist in caring for the physical needs of the children
-  Maintain safety of children by appropriately supervising program participants at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS:

-  Love for helping children learn and read.
-  Experience and enthusiasm for supervising multiple children.
-  Must be sensitive to diverse cultural and situational needs with a mature, non-judgmental attitude towards clients and their children.
-  Must be at least 18 years old.
-  Willingness to undergo a background check.
-  Ability to maintain client confidentiality.

ORIENTATION AND TRAINING PROVIDED: Volunteers may be required to participate in the agency's orientation. On-site supervision and training are provided by staff at the facility.

COMMITMENT REQUIRED: Regular weekly opportunities and short-term opportunities available. Flexibility is appreciated as the needs of the program fluctuate based on the number of children staying at the facility.

LOCATION OF JOB: Children's Learning Center located at New Directions for Families facility in Littleton, CO. The address of the facility is kept confidential to help ensure the security of our clients. All Arapahoe House locations are smoke-free environments.
