MISSION: The mission of Arapahoe House is to provide a continuum of accessible, affordable, and effective services for individuals and families with alcohol, drug and other behavioral health problems.



TITLE OF POSITION: Food Bank Volunteer

OBJECTIVE: Help two organizations at once! Volunteers at Food Bank of the Rockies warehouse can ask their time be credited to *Arapahoe House Case Management*, providing food credits for Arapahoe House. In addition, assistance is needed in organizing Arapahoe House's food bank for client use.




DUTIES MAY INCLUDE:

-  Duties vary based on needs of Food Bank of the Rockies
-  Duties frequently involve activities such as packing and sorting boxes of food donations
-  Arranging food donations at Arapahoe House for clients

COMMITMENT REQUIRED:

-  Volunteer Warehouse Shifts are in 3 hour blocks
-  Volunteers may also assist at the Arapahoe House food bank as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

-  Ability to perform physical labor for 3 hours.
-  Volunteers must be at least 14 years of age.
-  Dress appropriately: shirt with sleeves and closed toes shoes.

ORIENTATION AND TRAINING PROVIDED: Volunteers may be required to participate in the agency's orientation. On-site supervision and training are provided by staff at the facility.
