MISSION: The mission of Arapahoe House is to provide a continuum of accessible, affordable, and effective services for individuals and families with alcohol, drug and other behavioral health problems.


TITLE OF POSITION: Garden Volunteer

OBJECTIVE: Provide a hands-on learning experience to adolescents in treatment focused on establishing and maintaining a vegetable and flower garden.






DUTIES MAY INCLUDE:

-  Lead clients in preparing, planting and maintaining gardens.
-  Assist staff in client supervision during activities.
-  Assist in acquiring donated gardening materials.
-  Willingness to undergo a drug test and background check.

COMMITMENT REQUIRED:

-  Volunteer is asked to help as needed on Thursday morning or Saturdays during gardening season.

QUALIFICATIONS:

-  Expertise or special knowledge of gardening.
-  Must be sensitive to diverse cultural and situational needs with a mature, non-judgmental attitude towards clients.
-  Experience supervising or teaching large groups helpful.
-  Willingness to undergo a drug test and background check.
-  Ability to maintain client confidentiality.

ORIENTATION AND TRAINING PROVIDED: Volunteers may be required to participate in the agency's orientation. On-site supervision and training are provided by staff at the facility.
