Did You Know?

- No level of alcohol during pregnancy is considered safe.
- Pregnant women between the ages of 15 and 17 have a higher rate of illicit drug use than their non-pregnant counterparts.
- National research shows that more than 11 percent of pregnant women between the ages of 15 and 44 use alcohol, of which, 3.7 percent report binge drinking.



- Approximately 32 percent of women who use illicit drugs during pregnancy also use alcohol and cigarettes. Using this data, it has been suggested that an estimated one million children each year are exposed to legal or illegal substances during gestation.

Colorado has higher rates of women who are pregnant and suffer from substance use disorders:

- In Colorado, approximately seven percent of females in drug and alcohol treatment are pregnant, compared to one percent nationwide.
- In Colorado, the number of pregnant women in need of substance abuse treatment was estimated to be between 1,962 and 5,103.
- Responsibility for children, coupled with little access to child care services, is one of the most significant and most frequently cited barriers among females who seek treatment.
