Ways to Incorporate Arapahoe House into your Estate Plans

Bequest

One of the easiest and most popular ways to leave a legacy with Arapahoe House. Here is sample language you can use:

I give, devise, and bequeath (dollar amount, percentage amount, or description of asset or residuary of my estate) to Arapahoe House (Tax ID Number 84-0705495), or its successor, now or formerly in the city of Thornton, 8801 Lipan, in the State of Colorado, to be used for its general purposes.

Charitable Gift Annuity

Through a simple contract, you agree to make a donation of cash, stocks or other assets to Arapahoe House. In return, we agree to pay you (and someone else, if you choose) a fixed amount each year for the rest of your life.

Retirement Plan

Perpetuating your gift through a retirement plan by designating Arapahoe House as a beneficiary for all or part of your retirement plan assets is simple and can save your loved ones the tax burden from these assets. Contributions count toward your minimum IRA annual distribution.
